- Broad Band System-Zytel and Spectrum are ready to go.
- they do not have the funding in place to pay the contractors. Once this is ironed out, they will get the connection in the various homes. Zytel has a contract to connect 3,812 homes and Spectrum has a contract to connect 606 homes. Material is already paid for and ready to go.
- ♣ The Parks and Recreation Department received a Grant of \$12,500.00 from the Community Foundation of Danville River and they will use this money to buy new playground equipment.
- Leconomic Development: The Board of Commissioners approved a contract for fifteen to twenty thousand dollars to cut timber at the Pelham Industrial Park. These funds will be used to put back into the park, cut and entrance from the road and signage.
