Old Business:

EDC Update- Tony Smith

- Broad Band System-Zytel pulled out of their contract for (Great Grant) The state will take over and divide the contract between Spectrum and Bright Speed 50/50 Early part of the Great Grant. Tony explained that this is probably a good thing.
- Had a conversation with Raleigh last week about the CAB Grant and they're going to take the total investments three point two million dollars (3.2 million) to get the project going. They are currently working with us taking bids. We are involved in the process and this time they will actually ask us for our input before they choose. This should be coming forward within the next month.
- **4** Projects: We have been talking currently about a daycare facility going into the Pelham Industrial Park.
- Project Anchor, which is the business prospecting for PCC, talks are ongoing, and we anticipate 1110 next week. Hopefully, we have gotten details worked out where we can move on.
- **We are currently clearing the Pelham Business Park Lot with the hope of taking that money and reinvesting in signage and interest. So, we can keep PCC interest.**

- PCC: Emily Buchanan:
  - The AG Summit is a two-day event. One day is for community members and ground UPS. We have the state president of Farm Bureau Sean Hardening coming to speak and give a keynote address. We are showcasing how we are collaborating too. Reinforcement in our community and help that continues to grow. There're some folks from NC State and A&T programs that will be there. You have some representatives from the North Carolina Department of Commerce who will be there as well.
  - We are going to showcase some things that they will provide breakfast, lunch, and we will actually take a charted bus out to the Seed Site. Luke Bernard is going to do a demonstration. Giving everybody a chance to see the site before we start construction. SEED updates will be given. The 2<sup>nd</sup> day, the 19<sup>th</sup>, is the day that we will bring the AG students to our campus. Local groups PPXC, PPFG, with local foods council, and others will be doing some.
